
INSTALLING AN INTERNAL DRAIN

What you will need:

- Internal Drain
- Flashing Tape
- Tape Primer
- Leaf Guard (if required)

- Screws
- Paint Brush/Mini Roller
- Seam Roller

Guide:



- 1. Cut the flange of the outlet back to a minimum 50mm on all sides.
- 2. Fit the outlet and fix to the roof deck with screws.
- **3.** Adhere the membrane to the deck as usual, avoiding getting any glue on the area over the outlet.
- **4.** Cut away the membrane sitting over the outlet including the flange.
 - Cut a piece of 228mm Flashing Tape to cover the outlet
- **5.** including its flange and 60mm in all directions. The corners of the tape should be curved.
- **6.** Place the tape over the outlet and mark the area on the EPDM.
- **7.** Apply Tape Primer over the marked area, including over the outlet flange and into the outlet pipe.
- 8. Allow the primer to flash off until it is touch dry.
- **9.** Apply the Flashing Tape to the membrane, pressing into the top section of the outlet.
- 10. Cut a hole from the centre of the tape to the inner edge of the outlet.
- Roller all the tape, including inside the outlet to remove all bubbles and ensure a good bond.
- 12. Fit any leaf guards.
